### NOTICE NO. 10 OF 2026

#### SHANNON ESTUARY – CAHIRACON

##### **Site Investigation Works**

Dept of Transport Marine Notice 09 of 2026 dated 10Feb2026 refers.

Mariners are advised of planned site investigation works in the vicinity of Cahiracon Point and extending to seaward towards the Cahiracon Buoy.

The works have been commissioned by Gas Networks Ireland (GNI) and will be conducted by Murphys International Limited (MIL) and Causeway Geotech. A number of sub-contractors may also be deployed.

The works are scheduled to commence on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> February and are expected to continue for approx. four (4) months.

The planned works include;

Geophysical Surveys incl multi-beam echosounder, side-scan sonar etc,  
Geotechnical investigations incl boreholes and grab sampling,  
Water sampling,  
Intertidal surveys, and  
Deploying met ocean buoys.
