## NOTICE TO MARINERS

### NOTICE NO. 11 OF 2026

#### SHANNON ESTUARY – CAHIRACON

#### Site Investigation Works

Marine Notice 10 of 2026 refers.

Mariners are advised of planned site investigation works in the vicinity of Cahiracon Point and extending to seaward towards the Cahiracon Buoy.

Phase 1 of survey works are scheduled to start Monday 16<sup>th</sup> February and are expected to continue for four (4) weeks.

Two different survey techniques will be used. The first involves towing a 330m streamer behind a vessel, (indicated by the green lines in image 1, Annex A). The second involves a 180m streamer (indicated by the red lines in image 2, Annex B).

Marine Craft as follows:

16<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> Feb: Shannon 1 ( Multicat).

01<sup>st</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> March: Ocean Navigator ( Multicat ).

Works are scheduled to be carried out over 12 hour periods.

Both Shannon 1 and Ocean Navigator will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch. 16 & Ch. 11.

Marine Operations will Co-ordinate shipping moves with Shannon 1 & Ocean Navigator.

Mariners are requested to give a wide berth to the survey vessels and to pass at a safe speed.


